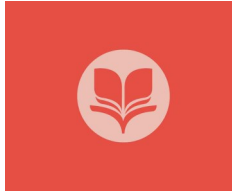

PRAYER

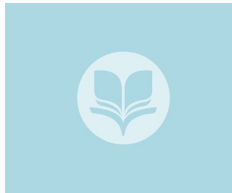
Please pray as we start to prepare for Holiday club, Holiday at Home and Summer Mission.

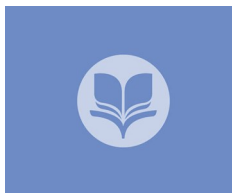
